

## SOSÚA:

### A Refuge for Jews in the Dominican Republic/Un Refugio de Judíos en la República Dominicana

#### **Exhibition contents:**

*Artifacts:* Over fifty-five original documents and three-dimensional artifacts, including the original telephone switchboard of the Sosúa administration building, the movie projector from the Sosúa movie theater, objects from the dairy industry and cattle farming. All documents are framed.

*Graphics:* More than thirty large-scale images, one text panel, two credit/donor panels. All text in the exhibition is bilingual (English and Spanish.)

*Films:* Three films with English and Spanish captioning.

*Exhibitry:* All walls (including labels adhered to them), casework, platforms, pedestals, carpet squares, audiovisual equipment and furniture are included.

#### **Additional materials:**

An electronic copy of the teacher's guide, which may be copied by the hosting institution; an electronic copy of the tour guide, press materials (including high resolution images and the template of a news release), and final art for a variety of collateral materials will be provided.

#### **Companion Volume:**

*Dominican Haven: The Jewish Refugee Settlement in Sosúa, 1940-1945*, by Prof. Marion Kaplan, published by the Museum in February 2008. The publication includes many photographs from the exhibition. Twenty-five copies of the publication are provided free of charge; others are available at additional cost.

**Size:** Approximately 1,500 square feet.

**Security:** Standard museum security required, including surveillance while open to the public.

**Rental Fee/Booking Period:** A \$10,000 rental fee for a sixteen-week block, plus the costs of design reconfiguration (if needed), installation and de-installation. Borrower pays for roundtrip shipping of exhibitry and artifacts.

**Shipping:** The exhibitry requires two 24' trucks or one 48' trailer. Artifacts are crated and ship separately from the exhibitry.

**Insurance:** Covered by the Museum of Jewish Heritage—A Living Memorial to the Holocaust.
